



## GREEK AWARDS

### [Fraternity Chapter President of the Year](#)

This award will be given to a fraternity chapter president who has made a lasting impact on the SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Community and their chapter during their presidential term. Students who served as a fraternity chapter president during the 2025 calendar year (January 2025 - December 2025) are eligible for this award. Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Sorority Chapter President of the Year](#)

This award will be given to a sorority chapter president who has made a lasting impact on the SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Community and their chapter during their presidential term. Students who served as a sorority chapter president during the 2025 calendar year (January 2025 - December 2025) are eligible for this award. Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Fraternity New Member of the Year](#)

This award will be given to a fraternity new member /neophyte who has, in their first year of membership, become an active and contributing member of the chapter and the SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Community. The nominee should have become affiliated with the chapter within the 2025 calendar year (January 2025 - December 2025). The winner will be selected based on their contributions to their chapter, Fraternity and Sorority Community, and SIUC and how they have surpassed expectations as a new member/neophyte. Letters of recommendation are encouraged but not required.



### [Sorority New Member of the Year](#)

This award will be given to a sorority new member /neophyte who has, in their first year of membership, become an active and contributing member of the chapter and the SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Community. The nominee should have become affiliated with the chapter within the 2025 calendar year (January 2025 - December 2025). The winner will be selected based on their contributions to their chapter, Fraternity and Sorority Community, and SIUC and how they have surpassed expectations as a new member/neophyte. Letters of recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Outstanding Council Officer of the Year](#)

This award will be given to individuals who have made a lasting impact on the SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Community during their term as a council executive board officer. Nominees must have served during the 2025 calendar year for the Interfraternity Council (IFC), College Panhellenic Association (CPA), National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC), or Multicultural Greek Council (MGC). There can be up to four winners in this category (one from each of the four governing councils). Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Outstanding Senior of the Year](#)

This award will be given to an outstanding senior member who has made significant contributions to their chapter, council, SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Community, and/or SIUC during their membership in their organization. You must include a minimum of one (1) letter of recommendation.



### Outstanding Greek of the Year

This will be awarded to an individual who has made a lasting impact at Southern Illinois University Carbondale. This nominee should have made a significant contribution to their chapter, the Fraternity and Sorority Community, and SIUC. Involvement and support of all aspects of Fraternity and Sorority Life will be considered, including, but not limited to: brotherhood/sisterhood, academics, community service, philanthropy, programming, leadership, campus involvement, and overall excellence. You must include a minimum of one (1) letter of recommendation.

### Most Improved Chapter

This award is to recognize a chapter who has successfully progressed throughout the 2025 calendar year (January 2025 - December 2025) and has seen significant improvements while exemplifying the values of their organization and SIU Fraternity and Sorority Life to the fullest. Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### Outstanding Fraternity of the Year

This award is to recognize a fraternity that has had outstanding success throughout the 2025 calendar year (January 2025–December 2025) while exemplifying the values of their organization and SIU Fraternity and Sorority Life to the fullest. This chapter should have made a significant contribution to their organization, the Fraternity and Sorority Community, SIUC, and/or the community as a whole. This chapter should represent high achievements in all areas, including but not limited to academics, philanthropy, and volunteer work. You must include a minimum of one (1) letter of recommendation.



### [Outstanding Sorority of the Year](#)

This award is to recognize a sorority that has had outstanding success throughout the 2025 calendar year (January 2025–December 2025) while exemplifying the values of their organization and SIU Fraternity and Sorority Life to the fullest. This chapter should have made a significant contribution to their organization, the Fraternity and Sorority Community, SIUC, and/or the community as a whole. This chapter should represent high achievements in all areas, including but not limited to academics, philanthropy, and volunteer work. You must include a minimum of one (1) letter of recommendation.

### [Outstanding Academic Programming](#)

This award is for the fraternity or sorority who demonstrated strong academic programming and success during the 2025 calendar year (January 2025-December 2025). Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Outstanding Campus Involvement](#)

This award is for the fraternity or sorority who demonstrated successful involvement across campus during the 2025 calendar year (January 2025-December 2025). Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Outstanding Philanthropy Event of the Year](#)

This will be awarded to a fraternity or sorority who hosted a successful philanthropy event or program during the 2025 calendar year (January 2025-December 2025). Letters of recommendation encouraged but not required.



### [Living Your Values Awards](#)

This award is given to a current member of the SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Community, who has and continues to exemplify the values of their organization. Letters of recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Advisor of the Year](#)

This award is to recognize an advisor who has gone above and beyond to provide support to the members of the chapter to whom he or she advises. This individual may be a chapter or faculty/staff advisor. Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Greek Alumni of the Year](#)

This award is to recognize an alumni member of the SIUC Fraternity and Sorority Life Community that has gone above and beyond to provide support to their chapter. They are a positive influence and volunteer their time to their organization. Letters of Recommendation are encouraged but not required.

### [Dr. Robert Andrew Morgan Engagement Award](#)

This award will be given to an individual, group, or business who has shown special dedication to working with the Fraternity and Sorority Community during the 2025 calendar year. Examples include but are not limited to philanthropy, non-profit organization, mentor, advocate, etc.
